Elementary Curriculum

Sources of Strength Elementary Curriculum is available to any Oregon school (K-6) as a part of the Oregon Health Authority's investment in upstream suicide prevention programming.

Implementing schools receive at no cost with OHA support:

- Registration at 2-day at a OHA Sponsored Oregon Exclusive Coaches Training (\$1,250 savings/staff)
- Stipend toward curriculum purchase up to \$1,750
- Technical assistance from Matchstick Consulting and Sources of Strength staff to support implementation.

- Partner with Matchstick Consulting to create an implementation plan.
